THE OBJECTIVES

THE NEXT SOCIETY (TNS) is a four-year EU-funded initiative launched in 2017 to strengthen inclusive entrepreneurship ecosystems across seven countries: Algeria, Egypt, Jordan, Lebanon, Morocco, Palestine and Tunisia. Led by ANIMA Investment Network and a 30-partner consortium, the project prioritised youth and gender empowerment, targeting 50% of entrepreneurs under 30 and 25% female participation. The Human Edge led the regional Mentoring Programme, training 130 mentors and matching 34 high-potential innovators with mentors to:

The programme was designed to:

- Develop the leadership and mentoring skills of ecosystem enablers—mentors drawn from across the region
- Support high-potential entrepreneurs to build their confidence, grow their businesses and create jobs
- Embed mentoring as a long-term support mechanism within national innovation ecosystems by strengthening local pools of trained mentors

THE CHALLENGE

Entrepreneurs across the region often face limited access to trusted guidance, local networks and long-term support. Many operate in volatile markets like in Lebanon and Tunisia at the time. Building effective, trust-based mentoring relationships across borders required cultural sensitivity, strong facilitation and clear alignment of expectations.

OUR APPROACH:

The Human Edge delivered 8 mentor training programmes over four years and 3 regional programmes that included a mentee preparation session, matching and pairing and setting up of 34 mentor-mentee relationships. Each cohort began with a Kickstart workshop and was supported through regular peer calls, refresher training and end-of-programme evaluations.

The programme design emphasised cultural relevance, relational depth and measurable impact—both for entrepreneurs and mentors.

Equipping both mentors and entrepreneurs with the skills and confidence needed to engage fully in the mentoring process.
