Planting the seeds for leadership and sustainable entreprise

#### THE OBJECTIVES

blueMoon, Ethiopia's first youth agribusiness incubator and seed investor, partnered with The Human Edge to pilot a tailored mentoring programme supporting early-stage agribusiness entrepreneurs. The programme aimed to:

- Pilot a new group mentoring model by matching one mentor with 2-3 co-founders per entrepreneurial team.
- Support business development, resilience and scalability of high-potential Ethiopian agri-startups.
- Strengthen personal leadership, entrepreneurial confidence and networking capacity among the entrepreneurs.
- Equip mentors with the mindset, skills and tools to empower others in their personal and professional lives.
- Create a pool of The Human Edge-trained mentors in Ethiopia to contribute to blueMoon's programmes and the wider ecosystem.

### THE CHALLENGE

With agriculture accounting for a large portion of Ethiopia's GDP but declining due to drought and environmental instability, the need for innovation in agribusiness was critical. While blueMoon incubated promising early-stage teams, many entrepreneurs lacked the confidence, leadership capacity and practical tools to scale their ideas into sustainable businesses. At the same time, Ethiopia had limited mentoring capacity and most entrepreneurs had never been part of a structured mentoring programme.

#### **OUR APPROACH:**

The Human Edge designed and implemented a 12-month mentoring pilot programme that included Mentoring Awareness Sessions and a kickstart workshop to onboard and train 6 local professional as mentors and pair them with 16 entrepreneurs across 6 teams. A structured relationship-based mentoring model focused on both personal and business development, a mid-year refresher and jam events to re-energise the community and deepen learning and reflection and continuous support to ensure mentoring relationships were sustained and meaningful.

#### **Human-centred design**

Grounded in relational mentoring, trust-building and deep contextual understanding to foster personal and entrepreneurial growth.

#### **Capacity for impact**

Equipping both mentors and mentees with the skills and confidence needed to engage fully in the mentoring process.

# Structured, scalable model

Cohort-based design combining mentor and mentee training, matching, and long-term support—adaptable to sector, stage and setting.

#### **On-going Support**

Supported mentoring pairs with regular check.ins and facilitated events to strengthen relationships and ensuire lasting outcomes.

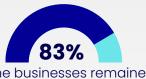
